We are pleased to announce the availability of Jet Reports version 24.1, which includes improvements to the Jet Hub user experience and security updates to align with Microsoft technology developments.

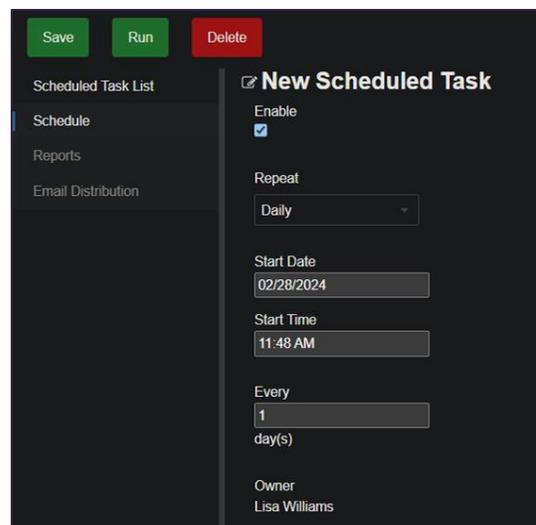

Jet Hub Scheduler – Alignment with Jet Reports UI

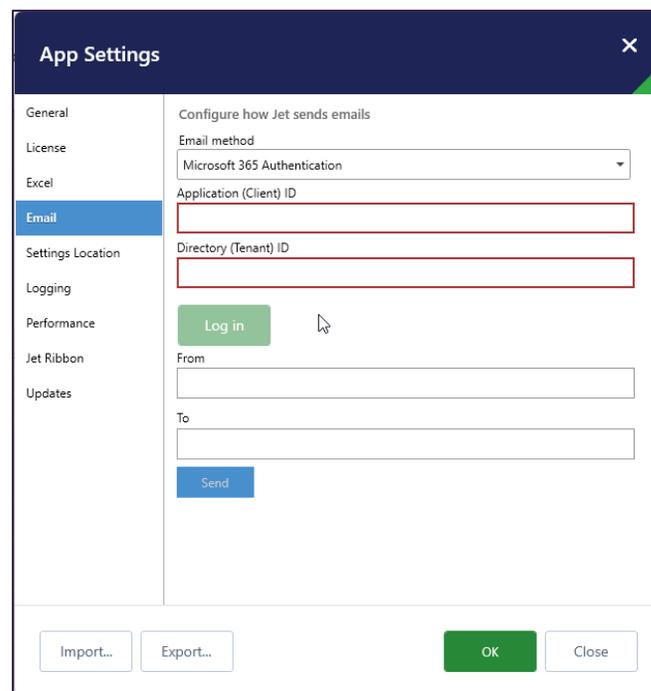
To modernize the UI and ensure a common user experience across Jet Reports and Jet Hub, the Jet Hub Scheduler has been updated to follow the same patterns and scheduling offerings found within the Jet Reports Excel add-in. This update will allow users to utilize the Jet Hub Scheduler in the same manner as they currently do with the Jet Reports scheduler.



Security Updates

SMTP Basic Authentication Deprecation Support

To deliver additional authentication options for Jet Reports and Jet Hub users leveraging multi-factor authentication and ensure compatibility with the deprecation of basic authentication in Exchange Online, Jet Reports and Jet Hub users can now use Microsoft 365 support within Jet to send emails. This allows Jet customers who have disabled App Password authentication within their Microsoft 365 accounts to continue sending secure emails.
